NO. 5 UNH SWEEPS UCONN TO TAKE HOME REGULAR SEASON TROPHY ~BU sweeps NU; BC and Vermont take three points in final weekend~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – After the final weekend of WHEA regular season play, the tournament pairings are set, and the 7th Annual WHEA Tournament promises to be an exciting event with the addition of the quarterfinal playoff round. During the week, No. 5 New Hampshire swept WHEA foe No. 10 Connecticut and defeated No. 9 Harvard in a mid-week matchup. No. 6 Boston College took three points from Providence, while Vermont did the same to Maine. Boston University swept Northeastern.

Tournament host and No. 1 overall seed New Hampshire started the week with a 3-2 victory over Harvard, behind a two-point performance by Jenn Wakefield (Pickering, Ont.) and eventual game-winner by Courtney Birchard (Mississauga, Ont.) with under a minute remaining in the game. In their weekend series, the Wildcats topped UConn twice, first by a score of 4-3 on Saturday and then 4-2 Sunday. Kelly Paton (Woodstock, Ont.) registered three points on Saturday, while Wakefield added another two. In Sunday's matchup, Kelly Cahill (Farmington Hills, Mich.) netted three points, as did Wakefield, bringing her weeklong total to seven points, earning her TPS Player of the Week honors.

The Eagles first downed the Friars 5-1 on Friday at Schneider Arena, as Kelli Stack (Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) tallied four assists and teammates Mary Restuccia (Chester Springs, Pa.) and Allie Thunstrom (Maplewood, Minn.) each registered three points. Back in action on Saturday, the teams stayed knotted through overtime, before PC won the shootout. Stack was the lone scorer for BC, while Erin Normore (Cambridge, Ont.) netted the only Friar goal. Pure Hockey Defensive Player of the Week Molly Schaus (Natick, Mass.) only allowed two goals on the weekend, stopping 51 Friar shots over two games.

Vermont took three points from Maine, first by way of a 1-0 shutout on Saturday. Rookie Caitlin Whitlock (Westfield, N.J.) earned the shutout, while Peggy Wakeham (Bay Roberts, Nfld.) netted the lone Catamount goal. Genevieve Turgeon (Lac Beauport, Que.) made 34 stops for the Black Bears in the losing effort. The teams skated to a 2-2 tie on Sunday, before Maine won the shootout. Turgeon made an impressive 47 saves in the game, while teammate Vanessa Vani (Mississauga, Ont.) netted both goals for the Black Bears.

In a preview of one of the quarterfinal matchups, BU and Northeastern played a home and home series. The Terriers swept the series, first with a 3-0 shutout by Allyse Wilcox (Grand Blanc, Mich.) and a two-point performance by Mission Rookie of the Week Jenelle Kohanchuk (Winnipeg, Man.). At Walter Brown on Sunday, BU's offense came alive with an 8-1 win. Thirteen Terriers got on the score sheet, led by Erin Seman (Ramsey, Minn.) and Melissa Anderson (Langley, BC), who each notched three points on the day. BU senior Gina Kearns (Norwood, Pa.) tallied two points on the afternoon, including her 100th career point as a Terrier.

JENN WAKEFIELD, UNH (PICKERING, ONT.)

Has a seven-game point-scoring streak with six multiple-point efforts, including each of the last four games, and totals of 9-5-14 in that span

VERMONT CATAMOUNTS

Their five Hockey East victories are the team's most in its fourth year in the league. UVM also set a program record with 26 power play goals

PEGGY WAKEHAM, VERMONT (BAY ROBERTS, NFLD.)

Her team-high 22 points (6-16-22) established a new UVM Division I single-season program record. She also set a new single-season mark for points by a defenseman and her 16 assists rank second overall and first by a D-I Catamount

CAITLIN WHITLOCK, VERMONT (WESTFIELD, N.J.)

Recorded her first career victory and shutout by blanking Maine, 1-0, Saturday, Feb. 21 at Gutterson Fieldhouse

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: With a win against Providence on Friday, Boston College secured second place in Hockey East and a quarterfinals bye in the Hockey East Tournament...Kelli Stack recorded a season-high four points in Friday's 5-1 win...The Eagles end the regular season having outscored their opponents 100-55, averaging 3.0 goals per game while holding their opponents to only 1.7 goals per game...Kelli Stack leads all Hockey East players in scoring with 53 points (21g, 32a) and Molly Schaus leads Hockey East goaltenders in save percentage (.941) and GAA (1.59).

Boston University: The Terriers finished the regular season in sole possession of third place in Hockey East, the team's best finish ever...Eight BU seniors recorded at least a point in their final regular season game on Sunday...Senior Gina Kearns became the first Terrier to reach 100 career points with a goal and an assist in Sunday's game...Kearns also set a BU single-season record with her third shorthanded goal of the season...BU enters the postseason unbeaten in its last six games...The Terriers will face Northeastern for the fourth time this month when BU hosts the Huskies in the first round of the WHEA Tournament...It will be the first time BU has faced the same team three games in a row, four times in a month and five times in a season.

University of Connecticut: Despite dropping the final two regular-season contests to UNH this weekend, the Huskies will compete in their third-consecutive Hockey East Tournament. UConn enters the post season in its lowest seed in program history and will meet Providence for the second-straight year. Team leader in assists, Cristin Allen, played in her 100th career game in the Huskies' 4-3 loss on Saturday. Allen has 22 assists going into the post season after collecting a pair on the power play this weekend.

University of Maine: Senior captain Vanessa Vani's two goals on Sunday gave her 36 for her career to go with 63 assists and 99 points, the most assists and third most points in program history...Maine's other senior Genevieve Turgeon broke her own record over the weekend, making 975 saves this season, the most in a season in Black Bear history...Freshman Myriam Croussette finished the campaign with six goals and 11 assists for 17 points, it is the most assists by a freshman since Vani recorded 13 in the 2004-05 season...Maine revamped its offense this season as they scored 67 goals, 16 more than all of last year including 13 more power play goals.

University of New Hampshire: UNH has the longest current unbeaten streak in the nation with its 13-game winning streak...This is the fourth consecutive year that UNH carries a double-digit unbeaten streak into postseason play...The Class of 2009 is the winningest in UNH history with 116 victories; they have won more than 90% of their home games as well as more than 90% of league games...The Wildcats are 6-0-2 vs. nationally-ranked teams since the start of December...UNH scored seven consecutive goals in the home-and-home series vs. UConn with the last three of Saturday's game and the first four of Sunday's game.

Northeastern University: Through the regular season, Northeastern has allowed 40 fewer goals in 2008-09 than in 2007-08, the biggest reduction of any team in Hockey East...Juniors Lindsay Berman (Odenton, Md.), Katy Applin (Palmer, Alaska), and Annie Hogan (Medford, Mass.) played their 100th career game Saturday against Boston University...Northeastern has as many regular season wins this season as in the past two seasons combined...The 2008-09 Huskies have the most road wins of any Northeastern team since 2003-04...Annie Hogan (Medford, Mass.) has set a new career-high for goals (5), assists (8), and points (13) in a season.

Providence College: The Friars earned their first shootout victory of the season on Saturday as Ashley Cottrell scored on PC's first attempt and Genevieve Lacasse stopped all three shots to keep Providence in the running for a first round home game...Erin Normore scored the lone goal for PC, she leads the senior class with 24 points (9g, 15a)...Providence reached the 17-win mark for the first time in three seasons...The Friars finished the past two seasons with 16 wins...With UNH's victory over Connecticut on Sunday, the Friars have never finished below fourth.

University of Vermont: Vermont (7-25-2, 5-15-1 Hockey East) wrapped up its 2008-09 with a 1-0 win over Maine Saturday and a 2-2 draw Sunday...UVM went 2-1-1 in its last four games to finish with 11 points, its best-ever Hockey East record in its fourth year in the league. Its five Hockey East victories are also new program high...Saturday's shutout was Vermont's first this year...The Cats lost a 2-1 shootout Sunday, the first-ever shootout at Gutterson Fieldhouse...UVM extended its school-record with its 26th power play goal Saturday. Seventeen of the 26 PPG came in Hockey East games...Sarah Smiddy (Grand Rapids, Mich.), Ashley Walenty (Lake Placid, N.Y.), Jessica Murphy (Shoreview, Minn.) and Danielle Ramirez (Huntington Beach, Calif.) played their final collegiate game Sunday at Gutterson. Smiddy tallied the tying goal and Walenty made 22 saves in net...Vermont will return its top eight scorers next season and its returnees accounted for 95% of its 57 goals this year.
