### 7TH ANNUAL WHEA CHAMPIONSHIP SEMIFINALS OPEN ON SATURDAY AT UNH $\sim$ No. 1 UNH meets No. 4 PC; No. 2 BC squares off against No. 3 BU $\sim$

WAKEFIELD, Mass. - The seventh annual Women's Hockey East kicks off on Saturday afternoon in Durham, N.H., with a noon game between fourth-seeded Providence and top-seed New Hampshire. The matchup between second-seeded Boston College and third-seeded Boston University will commence at 3pm at the Whittemore Center. Both semifinal games will be streamed live on the internet by B2 networks at www.b2tv.com.

The Wildcats hope to use home ice to their advantage, as they have never lost a game at home vs. a Hockey East opponent (64-0-9) in seven years. The teams in this game have combined to win all six WHEA Tournament titles since the league's inception in

2002. Providence College won the first three league tournaments, while New Hampshire has been victorious in the last three. The Friars, however, look to continue their postseason success, as they are coming off a 3-0 shutout of Connecticut last weekend in the guarterfinal round. While the Wildcats have won the last two meetings between the teams, on Feb. 13 and 14, the Friars also handed them a 5-0 shutout on Jan. 10. UNH's Jenn Wakefield (Pickering, Ont.) is looking to notch her 50th point of the year, as she currently leads the team with 49. Wakefield was recently named TPS Hockey Player of the Month for her fourteen-point February over the course of seven undefeated games. PC's rookie netminder Genevieve Lacasse (Scarborough, Ont.) leads the league with a .940 save percentage in league play.

Crosstown Rivals BU and BC last met on Feb. 14, when they skated to a 3-3 tie, before the Terriers won the shootout. Earlier in the season, the teams split a 4-1 BU victory and 5-0 BC shutout. Both teams hope to carry their momentum to Durham, as they are each unbeaten in their last seven games. The Eagles are led offensively by league point leader Kelli Stack (Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) and in net by Molly Schaus (Natick, Mass.), who has registered ten shutouts on the year. BU is led by rookie standout Jenelle Kohanchuk (Winnipeg, Man.), who has tallied 29 points in 27 games played.

The seventh annual WHEA Championship Game will be played on Sunday, March 8 at 12:30 p.m. The game will be broadcast on NESN on a tape delay basis at 4 p.m. on
