NEW HAMPSHIRE CAPTURES FOURTH STRAIGHT WHEA TOURNEY TITLE

~UNH and BC qualify for NCAA Tournament this weekend~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – The University of New Hampshire captured its fourth consecutive Women's Hockey East tournament title at the Seventh Annual WHEA Championship weekend in Durham. UNH advanced to the finals after defeating Providence 3-1 on Saturday afternoon. The Eagles of Boston College downed cross-town rival Boston University 3-2 on Saturday, to take on UNH in the championship. UNH came away with a 2-1 victory on Sunday, its 15th consecutive victory.

In Saturday's first match-up, the Wildcats came out strong, owning a 12-3 shot advantage in the first frame before the Friars turned the tables, outshooting them 12-6 in the second. TPS Hockey Player of the Week Kacey Bellamy (Westfield, Mass.) opened scoring in the first, with a power play goal at 14:31, while teammate Kelly Paton (Woodstock, Ont.) tallied a pair of assists on the afternoon. Netminder Kayley Herman (Weyburn, Sask.) stopped 21-of-22 shots in the Wildcat victory. Providence's Genevieve Lacasse (Scarborough, Ont.) made 25 saves in the losing effort, while Abby Gauthier (Lynn, Mass.) scored the lone Friar goal.

In the second semi-final game, BC topped BU 3-2. Kelli Stack (Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) had a hand in all three BC goals, recording a goal and a pair of assists. BU's Lauren Cherewyk (St. Albert, Alb.) put the Terriers on top at the start of the game, but the Eagles tied it at one goal apiece before the first stanza was over. BU outshot the Eagles 38-21, including a 19-6 advantage in the first. The Terriers were unable to capitalize on their opportunities, however, as BC netminder Molly Schaus (Natick, Mass.) made 36 saves in her 22nd victory of the year earning her Pure Hockey Defensive Player of the Week honors. Allie Thunstrom (Maplewood, Minn.) netted a goal and added an assist in the Eagle victory, while Mission Rookie of the Week, BU's Jenelle Kohanchuk (Winnipeg, Man.) and junior Melissa Anderson (Langley, B.C.) each gathered two points in the loss.

In the championship game, it was the Wildcats that came out on top with a 2-1 victory. Bellamy struck first again, this time 10:40 into the game, while Paton added another two assists. Teammate Micaela Long (South Boston, Mass.) netted the eventual game-winner later in the period. Meghan Fardelmann (Lansing, Kan.) scored the lone Eagle goal in the third period. Undefeated rookie netminder Lindsey Minton (Richardson, Texas) stopped 20-of-21 shots en route to her tenth win of the year.

Three UNH players were named to the all-tournament team, including MVP Bellamy, Courtney Birchard (Mississauga, Ont.) and Paton. BC's Schaus and Stack were also all-tournament team honorees.

UNH enters the NCAA tournament on a 15-game win streak and will host Minnesota-Duluth at the Whittemore Center next Saturday, March 14. Despite the loss, BC's season will continue, heading to Minnesota for an NCAA Quarterfinal match on Saturday (5pm), as well.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: Boston College qualified for the NCAA tournament over the weekend, claiming the seventh spot in the 8 team field...The Eagles will travel to Minnesota to take on the Golden Gophers on Saturday at 4 p.m. central time with a spot in the Frozen Four in Boston on the line...Junior goaltender Molly Schaus and junior forward Kelli Stack earned spots on the Hockey East All-Tournament team on Sunday afternoon...Schaus made 57 saves in two games over the weekend, two shy of setting a new Hockey East record for saves in the tournament...The Eagles earned eight awards at the Hockey East banquet on Friday including three First team All-Stars and Player of the Year honors for Stack for the second time in her career...Entering the NCAA match-up with Minnesota the Eagles are netting 3.0 g/gm and allowing only a stingy 1.7.

Boston University: The Terriers finished their season at 18-11-7, setting a program record for fewest losses in a season...Freshman Jenelle Kohanchuk was involved in both BU goals in Saturday's semifinal loss to BC and carries a seven-game point streak into next season...Sophomore Lauren Cherewyk (St. Albert, Alb.) scored her first postseason goal...Senior Gina Kearns (Norwood, Pa.) concludes her career as BU's all-time leading scorer with 102 points (50g, 52a). She is the only player to play in every game in program history...Senior Allyse Wilcox (Grand Blanc, Mich.) leaves with BU's goaltending records, finishing her career with a 2.32 GAA, .916 save percentage, 43 wins and seven shutouts.

University of New Hampshire: UNH captured its fourth consecutive Hockey East tourney title by upending Providence, 3-1, in the semifinal and Boston College, 2-1, in the championship game...UNH's 15-game winning streak is the longest since the '06 team won 17 straight...Head coach Brian McCloskey garnered his fourth league Coach of the Year honor in '09...UNH had a league-high three representatives on the First Team All-Star list...Four 'Cats, including Kacey Bellamy as the Tourney MVP, were named to the All-Tournament Team. This was Bellamy's third selection to the All-Tourney Team...UNH will be the host of an NCAA Regional for the fourth consecutive year; the Wildcats won two of the previous three...The 'Cats are 14-0-3 at home this year and unbeaten in 30 consecutive home games (26-0-4)...UNH has a 10-3 lifetime record in the league tournament...UNH is 7-0-2 in its last nine games vs. nationally-ranked teams.

Providence College: The Friars season came to an end with a 3-1 loss at UNH in the Hockey East semifinals on Saturday...Abby Gauthier scored her third goal of the season for Providence...The freshman and senior classes dominated the scoring for PC this year...The class of 2012 accounted for 42% (36 of 86) of the goals scored while the seniors registered 36% (31 of 86) of all tallies...Laura Veharanta finished the season with 16 goals to lead all players...She becomes the first Providence freshman to lead the team in scoring since Friar great Cammi Granato scored 24 in 1989...Senior Erin Normore finished her career tied for first all-time with 143 games played...Brittany Simpson finished tied for second with 141 games played...Genevieve Lacasse finished with the fourth-best single season gaa (1.94) and fourth-highest save total (756).
