## MAINE BLACK BEARS OPEN WITH SERIES SWEEP OF SACRED HEART ~WHEA teams win three of five exhibition contests~

**WAKEFIELD, Mass.** – The Black Bears opened the season with a series sweep of Sacred Heart over the weekend at Alford Arena. Maine shutout the Pioneers on Friday night, 9-0, and then came back with an 11-goal effort on Saturday.

The Black Bears were led offensively by Pure Hockey/Hockey East Player of the Week Jennie Gallo (Castlegar, B.C.) and senior forward Jenna Ouellette (Winnipeg, Man.), each of whom recorded seven points in the weekend series. Gallo opened the season with a four-point effort on Friday, including her first career hat trick, while Ouellette tallied a career-high four assists on Saturday. Sophomore goalie Candice Currier (Goffstown, N.H.) made 16 saves in her first collegiate shutout on Friday, which her fourth career start for the Black Bears.

Connecticut shutout Dawson, 6-0, on Friday night at Freitas Ice Forum in exhibition action, as sophomore blueliner Rebecca Hewett (Oak Bluff, Man.) amassed four assists on the night for the Huskies.

Four-time defending Hockey East Champion New Hampshire posted a 13-0 shutout of the Durham Jr. Lightning on Saturday night at the Whittemore Center. Julie Allen (Brampton, Ont.; 2g, 2a) and Brittany Skudder (Plainview, N.Y.; 4a) each notched four points apiece for the Wildcats. Boston University also defeated Durham Jr. on Sunday by a score of 7-1 at Walter Brown Arena. Junior forward Lauren Cherewyk (St. Albert, Alb.) led the Terriers on offense with a pair of goals.

Northeastern was the only team to play a pair of exhibition games on the weekend. The Huskies edged Dawson on Saturday afternoon, 2-1, and then dropped a 3-1 decision to McGill on Sunday. Sophomore goalie Florence Schelling (Oberengstringen, Switzerland) amassed 27 saves in the loss to McGill on Sunday.

Providence College opened with McGill on Saturday at Schneider Arena in a 7-4 loss. Sophomore Laura Veharanta (LaVerne, Calif.) tallied three points (2g, 1a) for the Friars.

Boston College and Vermont were idle this weekend and begin play this coming weekend.

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** The Eagles will open the season on Friday, Oct. 2 at Clarkson and will return to Chestnut Hill the following week to take on Syracuse for the first home contest of the year on Friday, Oct. 9...the Eagles will be without two of their top players as both forward Kelli Stack (Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) and goalie Molly Schaus (Natick, Mass.) will spend this season with the U.S. Women's National Team...The Eagles return three of their top four scorers back to the Heights, which includes: Allie Thunstrom (Maplewood, Minn.), Mary Restuccia (Chester Springs, Pa.) and Danielle Welch (Hastings, Minn.).

**Boston University:** BU women's hockey defeated the Durham Jr. Lightning, 7-1, in an exhibition matchup at Walter Brown Arena on Sunday...Six different players scored goals for the Terriers, who outshot the Lightning 51-7 on the afternoon...Multiple point scorers for the Terriers were junior Lauren Cherewyk (2g), junior Jillian Kirchner (Frankfort, Ill.;1g,1a), junior Holly Lorms (Wauwatosa, Wis.;1g,1a), senior Jonnie Bloemers (Brooklyn Center, Minn.;1g,1a)...The Terriers held a 2-1 advantage after two periods of play, but erupted for five scores in the final stanza, firing 24 shots to Durham's 1 in the third period.

**University of Connecticut:** The momentum of a 6-0 win over Dawson College in exhibition play should carry over to the University of Connecticut's opening weekend against UNH and Northeastern on Oct. 3 and 4...Saturday's start to the regular season marks the first time since the 2005-06 season that women's ice hockey starts the year on the road and it is the first time in program history that the Huskies do so against a Hockey East opponent.

**University of Maine:** Maine opened the 2009-10 season on Friday night with a 9-0 victory of Sacred Heart...Sophomore Candice Currier picked up the win in net for Maine, making 16 saves in her first shutout of the season...The Black Bears continued the goal scoring when they defeated Sacred Heart on Saturday afternoon, 11-4...Maine was led by senior Taryn Peacock as she had two goals to go along with two assists...Fellow senior Jenna Ouellette was a huge part of the offensive attack on Saturday as she assisted on four of the Black Bear goals...The Black Bears return to the ice next Friday night when they open up Hockey East play at Providence.

**University of New Hampshire:** UNH skated to a 13-0 victory against the Durham Jr. Lightning (AA Intermediate) in its only exhibition game of the season; the Wildcats went 5-for-6 on the power play and 6-for-6 on the penalty kill; 14 skaters recorded at least one point; 11 had multiple-point efforts, senior captain Kelly Paton (Woodstock, Ont.; 3a), classmate Micaela Long (So. Boston, Mass.; 1g,2a) and freshman Kristina Lavoie (Fonthill, Ont.; 2g,1a) each recorded three points; Lindsey Minton (Richardson, Texas) and Kayley Herman (Weyburn, Sask) combined in net for the shutout; UNH opens the 2009-10 season at home against league rival UConn; the 'Cats also opened the 2004 season at home vs. the Huskies with a 4-2 victory.

**Northeastern University:** Northeastern played a pair of exhibitions this weekend against Dawson College on Saturday and McGill University on Sunday. Northeastern won its exhibition opener for the third time in the last four years...The game against McGill was the first meeting in 11 years between the teams (NU won previous meeting on 11/7/98 by a 3-1 score)...Junior Lori Anfflick (Thornhill, Ont.) has now recorded a point in two of her last three exhibition games...The Huskies did not allow a goal in the first period of either exhibition game.

**Providence College:** PC faces off against Maine in a pair of home contests to be held at Schneider Arena this weekend...The Friars defeated Maine, 4-1, both times the two teams met...PC owns a 26-1-5 record all-time against the Black Bears...Providence looks to improve on its first-weekend record as PC stands at 6-10-4 during Coach Deraney's 10-year tenure.

**University of Vermont:** The Catamounts will play their first nine games at home this season, they don't hit the road until Nov. 6 at Boston College...The Catamounts return two team MVP's from the last three years in goalie Kristin Olychuck (Kelowna, B.C.) and forward Chelsea Furlani (Colchester, Vt.)...Vermont returns 18 players from last year's team, including over 90 percent of its team scoring...The Catamounts officially open the season against Union, they swept Union last year, by a combined score of 10-3...The Catamounts will carry 22 players on their roster for the 2009-10 season, marking the fewest number players under head coach Tim Bothwell at UVM.
