UCONN EARNS TWO VICTORIES VS. ECAC; NORTHEASTERN SWEEPS BEMIDJI ~Vermont splits with Princeton; BU, UNH tie up St. Lawrence~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – Northeastern swept Bemidji State, while UConn won both games against ECAC opponents. No. 9 ranked Boston University and No. 3 UNH traveled to the North Country this weekend as they both picked up ties against St. Lawrence. Vermont split their weekend series with Princeton.

UConn dominated Brown in an 8-2 score on Friday. Pure Hockey Player of the Week Michelle Binning (Oshawa, Ont.) led the Huskies and registered four points (2g,2a) on the night. UConn also downed Union by a score of 4-1 on Saturday.

Northeastern pick up its fourth and fifth victories of the season with back to back wins over Bemidji State. In an exciting third period comeback for the Huskies Junior Kristi Kehoe (Bakersfield, Calif) and senior Annie Hogan (Medford, Mass) each scored within 1:25 seconds of each other in Saturday's win.

The Catamounts boasted another big win this weekend defeating Princeton for the first time in school history on Friday night at Gutterson Fieldhouse. Sophomore Kailey Nash (Middletown, R.I.) had a game-high three points (1g,2a) in Friday's win. On Saturday the Tigers split the series and defeated Vermont, 7-2.

The Terriers dropped a 7-2 decision to No. 4 Clarkson Saturday night in their first loss of the season. Friday night the Terriers skated to a 2-2 tie against St. Lawrence out shooting their opponents 35-29.

UNH was also defeated by Clarkson and recorded at tie against St. Lawrence. In Saturday's 3-3 tie, the Wildcats were led by Hockey East Rookie of the Week Brittany Skudder's (Plainview, N.Y.) two goals.

Providence was defeated by Brown this Sunday in the 15th annual Mayor's Cup at Schneider Arena. Sophomore Abby Gauthier (Lynn, Mass.) scored the Friar's lone goal in the first period, but Brown rallied to score five unanswered goals. Sophomore netminder Genevieve Lacasse (Scarborough, Ont.) recorded 20 saves for the Friars the previous night in a 2-2 tie vs. Yale.

The University of Maine also lost twice to Robert Morris. The Black Bears hosted their annual "Skating Strides Against Breast Cancer" game on Saturday afternoon.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: Boston College was idle over the weekend...they will return to the ice on Monday, November 2 at BU. The Eagles went 2-1-1 against the Terriers in 2008-09, with BC knocking off its archrival in the Hockey East tournament, 3-2...Freshman forward Ashley Motherwell (St. Charles, Ill.) is currently tied for sixth place in Hockey East among freshman scorers with four points (0-4-4)...Freshman goaltender Corinne Boyles (Wheaton, Ill.) currently sits in second place for save percentage in Hockey East with .934.

Boston University: With a tie against St. Lawrence, BU has recorded four ties already this season, tied for second most in program history. The Terriers have played two career games against SLU and both have ended in 2-2 ties...BU's unbeaten streak of six games to start the 2009-10 season matches it's longest unbeaten streak to begin a season in program history, as the 2006-07 Terriers went 6-0-0 in their first six games...Senior forward Jonnie Bloemers (Brooklyn Center, Minn.) netted her first goal of the season to give BU a 1-0 lead against the Saints.

University of Connecticut: UConn swept a pair of ECAC opponents with wins at Brown and against Union on Friday and Saturday, respectively. The Huskies offense erupted as three players finished with three points at Brown, including a pair of two-goal scores in Michelle Binning and Elisabeth Stathopulos...In the 8-1 victory at Brown, UConn scored in every possible situation, with Amy Hollstein netting the short-handed goal, the first of her career. An early deficit was no problem for the Huskies as they surpassed Union in a 4-1 game at Mark Edward Freitas on Saturday. Monique Weber power play, marking the second-consecutive game that UConn has scored twice with the man advantage. UConn's power play was 4-for-12 while holding their opponents fruitless in six combined chances.

University of Maine: Maine dropped a pair of hard battles to Robert Morris over the weekend...Ashley Norum (Fairbanks, Alaska) recorded her first goal of the season Friday night when she slapped home a power play goal from the point...Jenna Ouellette picked up an assist on the goal, her eleventh in nine games to lead the team which is already two more than she compiled all of last year...Ouellette is third in the league in total points with eleven and tied for the Hockey East lead with nine assists...Brittany Ott carried her first shutout of her career into overtime Saturday afternoon as she was solid in net, making 17 saves for the Maine before dropping a 1-0 decision...Maine has now have eight power play goals this season including scoring at least one power play goal in five out of their first nine games...Maine has killed off 39 penalties this year...The Black Bears have scored 26 goals this year, good for second in Hockey East with a 2.89 GPG average.

University of New Hampshire: Senior forward and captain Kelly Paton has recorded a point in all eight games; dating back to last season, her point-scoring streak is 17 games...Junior defenseman Courtney Sheary (Melrose, Mass.) matched her career high of two assists at St. Lawrence...Freshman forward Kristine Horn (Utica, Mich.) has a four-game point-scoring streak and has tallied a point in six of eight games...UNH has scored multiple power-play goals in five of eight games and is 14-for-36 (38.9%) overall this season...UNH has had a balanced attack, which is evident by three skaters tied for the team lead in goals with four and three more 'Cats at three apiece...The Wildcats have scored 13 of their 27 goals in the second period...UNH is unbeaten in league home games (63-0-9) since the inception of Hockey East in the 2003 season.

Northeastern University: Senior Lindsay Berman has three game-winning goals in seven games this season, already eclipsing her total from the past three years combined (Berman had two game-winners in her three prior years with NU)...For the second straight season, the Huskies have not allowed more than two goals in a game over the first seven games of the season...Northeastern is unbeaten when they have more than 22 shots on goal this season (5-0-1)...Northeastern is 3-0-1 when they are outshot in a game this season.

Providence College: Providence finished the week 0-1-1... Led by Ashley Cottrell's (Sterling Heights, Mich.) five goals and two assists, the sophomore class has been responsible for 38 percent of the team's total scoring...Providence will host No.9 BU on Saturday at 2:00 p.m. before traveling to UConn on Sunday for a 4pm game in Storrs...Sophomore goalie Genevieve Lacasse (Scarborough, Ont.) boasts a 3-1 record vs. UConn with 116 saves and two shutouts, including a 3-0 blanking in last year's WHEA Quarterfinal...Last season, the Friars outscored Connecticut, 11-3 behind six points (2g,4a) from Laura Veharanta (La Verne, Calif.)...PC stands at 23-3-1 all-time against BU.

University of Vermont: The University of Vermont split a weekend series with Princeton ... The Catamounts used a three-goal second period on Friday to help fuel a 4-3 victory ... Kailey Nash, Chelsea Furlani (Colchester, Vt.), Maggie Walsh and Brittany Nelson (Shelburne, Vt.) all found the back of the net for UVM...The 4-3 victory marked the first win over Princeton in school-history ... On Saturday the Catamounts fell 7-2 despite jumping out to a 1-0 lead. Nash and Nelson found the back of the net again...Kristen Olychuck (Kelowna, B.C.) made 49 saves over the weekend.
