BOSTON COLLEGE SWEEPS UCONN; BU, PC SPLIT HOME-AND-HOME ~Maine, NU each take two points; Terriers shutout UVM~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – In a midweek match up, BU shutout Vermont, 4-0, while Northeastern split its series against Maine. Bauer Rookie of the Week Nicole Anderson (Jordan, Minn.) led Providence to a 6-2 win against BU on Sunday with her first career hat trick. BC shutout UConn 4-0 on Sunday and grabbed an extra point in the standings on Saturday in a shootout win.

Northeastern skated to a 5-1 victory Saturday afternoon at Matthews Arena. Four Huskies recorded a two-point game. Northeastern netminder Florence Schelling (Oberengstringen, Switzerland) had a solid weekend performance as well stopping 67 shots on the weekend. Northeastern hosted their “Skating Strides Against Breast Cancer” game on Sunday, but Maine bounced back and shutout Northeastern 1-0. Jenna Ouellette (Winnipeg, Man.) scored the lone goal of the game for Maine. Maine’s Brittany Ott (St. Clair Shores, Mich.) made 34 saves for her first career shutout.

No. 7 ranked BU edged Providence on Saturday at Aggains Arena with a score of 5-3. The Terriers went 4-for-7 on the power play, including two goals from senior Melissa Anderson (Langley, BC). Sunday was a different story as Providence boasted a big win against BU by a 6-2 score. Nicole Anderson and teammate Ashley Cottrell (Sterling Heights, Mich.) each tallied four-point performances for the Friars in the victory.

BC and UConn battled in a 0-0 tie on Saturday at Freitas Ice Forum. The Huskies outshot the Eagles 33-18 but BC’s Allie Thunstrom (Maplewood, Minn.) scored the only shootout goal giving BC the extra point. UConn was defeated by BC on Sunday afternoon, 4-0. Boston College Freshman goalie Corinne Boyles (Wheaton, Ill.) stopped all 42 shots she faced in her first career shutout for the Eagles.

The UNH and Vermont game originally schedule for Saturday, November 14 at Gutterson Fieldhouse was postponed and will be rescheduled at a later date.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: The Eagles goalie tandem of Corinne Boyles and Kiera Kingston have teamed up to put BC in a tie for second place in the league for scoring defense with only 23 goals allowed on the season thus far...senior forward Allie Thunstrom is currently tied for second in Hockey East in goals scored this season with eight in twelve games...the Eagles will host Boston University this Wednesday night at 7:00 p.m. for the second game of the season against their archrivals...BC was able to skate past the Terriers in the first matchup of the year with a 2-1 win on Monday, Nov. 2 at Walter Brown Arena in Boston, Mass.

Boston University: With the win over Vermont, BU moved to 7-0-0 lifetime against the Catamounts at Walter Brown Arena, with five of the seven wins being shutouts...Melissa Haber recorded her sixth career shutout and now stands one shy of the program career shutout mark...The Terriers matched a program record with four power-play goals in a 5-3 win over Providence at Agganis Arena...The last time BU recorded four power-play goals was also at Agganis Arena in an 8-1 win over Maine last season...In three career games at Agganis Arena, the Terriers are 2-0-1...BU recorded 40 shots for the first time this season in the 6-2 loss to Providence...The Terriers were 4-0-0 last season when they tallied 40+ shots...The loss to Providence marks the first time in program history the Terriers have lost the first game in their longest road stretch of the season, holding a 1-0-3 mark in such games over the previous four years.

University of Connecticut: For the first time since November of last season, the Huskies suffered back-to-back shutouts in regulation against a Hockey East opponent. On Saturday, UConn fell in a shootout for the third time this season to Boston College at Mark Edward Freitas Ice Forum. Sophomore Alexandra Garcia (Pointe-Claire, Que.) made 18 saves in the 0-0 tie. The game marked the first time that UConn and its opponent were unable to score after 65 minutes of play since a Jan. 4 game against Princeton in 2008. The Eagles translated their shootout victory momentum into a 4-0 win at Kelley Rink on Sunday. Shutout for the second consecutive afternoon by an Eagle netminder, the Huskies have not scored on Boston College since then-junior Michelle Binning (Toronto, Ont.) netted a power-play gamewinner on December 4 in Storrs against a then-No. 7 Eagle squad. After a bit of rest this week, the Huskies will face Quinnipiac at 7 p.m. in the second game of the Nutmeg Classic, hosted by Yale this season. This year is the first that all four teams are from the state of Connecticut with Sacred Heart and Yale.

University of Maine: Maine (3-9-2, 1-5-2-1 HE) split their series at Northeastern this weekend, dropping a 5-1 decision on Saturday before shutting out the Huskies 1-0 on Sunday...The win gives Maine its first Hockey East win of the season...Brittany Ott (St. Clair Shores, Mich.) picked up her first career Hockey East victory and also recorded her first career shutout with the win on Sunday over the Huskies after shutting down all 34 shots she faced...Ott has now made 30 or more saves in her last three starts for the Black Bears...Ouellette picked up the game-winning goal for Maine on Sunday, giving her four goals and 13 total points, just five points shy of her last year total and two points shy of 50 for her career...Ouellette also now leads the team in power play points with seven...Maine returns to action on Nov. 24 when they host Boston University in a neutral site game at the Androscoggin Bank Coliseum in Lewiston, Maine.

University of New Hampshire: UNH's Whittemore Center will be the site of Sunday's Hockey East All-Stars vs. U.S. National Team exhibition game, and Wildcats Courtney Birchard, Micaela Long and Kelly Paton will skate against UNH alum Kacey Bellamy, who captained last year's team...The four-member senior class accounts for 50% of the team's 72 assists...UNH has a current unbeaten streak of five games (3-0-2)...The Wildcats opened the season with a six-game unbeaten streak (5-0-1)...UNH is 7-0-1 when recording 30+ shots in a game...The 'Cats have held the opposition to less than 20 shots six times and have won every game...UNH has won all seven games in which it has surrendered less than three goals...The Wildcats are 2-0 in games decided by one goal...New Hampshire has scored the game's first goal in six of 12 games and is 3-0-3 in those games; the 'Cats are 5-1-0 when the opponent takes a 1-0 lead...Nine of UNH's 12 games have been at home.

Northeastern University: The Huskies have allowed one goal or less in eight straight games. The last time the Huskies accomplished this feat was during the 1991-92 season (18 years ago)...The Huskies are unbeaten this season when junior Kristi Kehoe (Bakersfield, Calif.) records a point (7-0-2)...Northeastern is the only team in the nation to average less than one goal against per game (0.90) this season...The Huskies are 5-1-2 when they are outshot in a game this season...Northeastern is undefeated when a freshman records a goal on the scoresheet (5-0-1)...The Huskies had not been shutout by Maine since Feb. 19, 2005 (0-5 L)...The Huskies have not beaten Maine in consecutive games since Jan. 19 and Feb. 15, 2003.

Providence College: Providence finished the weekend, 1-1, splitting a pair of games with No. 7/8 Boston University...Freshman Nicole Anderson netted the first PC hat trick on Sunday since current junior Alyse Ruff put home three goals against Northeastern on February 17, 2008...Anderson matched her season point total with her four-point performance on Sunday...Providence scored as many goals this weekend (nine) as it has the previous seven games combined...The Friars scored three power-play goals on Friday, the most since PC netted four against Colgate on October 11, 2008...Sophomore goaltender Genevieve Lacasse ranks second in the nation with 347 saves on the season and needs only 45 more to move into the top-five all-time at Providence.

University of Vermont: Vermont dropped a 4-0 decision to Boston U on Wednesday while its game on Saturday against UNH was postponed...UVM had a streak of 22 consecutive penalty kills that was snapped in the loss to Boston U in the second period...The streak was the longest in school history...The power-play goal by Boston U was the first power-play goal allowed by UVM in Hockey East...Sophomore Kailey Nash (Middletown, R.I.) is currently second in the nation with five power-play goals this year.
