## UNH'S KELLY PATON TABBED WHEA PLAYER OF THE MONTH FOR NOVEMBER ~BU's Cardella named Top Rookie; NU's Schelling chosen as Top Goalie~



### WHEA Player of the Month Kelly Paton – New Hampshire Senior Forward; Woodstock, Ont.

Paton recorded seven goals and six assists for 13 points in six November games, averaging 2.17 points per game. Paton's other numbers included two game-winning goals, a +6 rating and a 21% shooting percentage. In four league games, she tallied nine points (4g,5a). She had five points (2g, 3a) in three games vs. nationally-ranked teams. Paton recorded her second career hat trick and also matched her personal best of four points vs. Rensselaer. She factored directly into 65% of the team's goals with 13 points (20 goals) and that included a stretch of a goal or assist on each of the last six goals of the month. Paton won back-to-back Player of the Week awards (Nov. 23 & 30). She wins the award for the second consecutive month to start the season.

### Bauer Goaltender of the Month Florence Schelling – Northeastern So., Goaltender; Oberengstringen, Switzerland

Schelling posted a 3-2-1 record in November, recording one shutout (vs. Vermont on Nov. 25) and posting a 1.32 GAA and a .958 save percentage. In 362:48 minutes, Schelling stopped 183 of 191 shots. She allowed one goal or less in four of six games and made 30 saves or more in four of six games. On Nov. 8 at Providence, Schelling stopped 11 of 13 shootout attempts, in addition to making 37 saves in regulation and overtime.
