BOSTON COLLEGE ENTERTAINS PROVIDENCE; MAINE TRAVELS TO UNION

~No. 4 New Hampshire battles intrastate rival Dartmouth~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. - Boston College and Providence College will meet in the lone conference game of the weekend on Friday night at Conte Forum, while Maine will travel to ECAC foe Union College beginning Friday afternoon in Schenectady, N.Y. No. 4 ranked New Hampshire will play a single-game at Dartmouth on Saturday night at Thompson Arena in Hanover.

The Eagles and Friars will meet for the first time this season, after BC won the season series last year, 2-0-1, outscoring them 9 to 3 in the series. PC is coming off a 4-1 win at New Hampshire last Saturday, handing UNH its first home loss in WHEA history. Friars' sophomore forward Ashley Cottrell (Sterling Heights, Mich.) ranks fourth in the league in scoring with 20 points and her 10 goals in third best among WHEA skaters. Freshman goaltender Corinne Boyles (Wheaton, III.) owns a .925 save percentage in 11 starts, which ranks fourth in Hockey East.

Maine' current six-game (3-0-3) unbeaten streak is currently the fourth longest undefeated streak in the nation. The Black Bears are coming off a weekend sweep of Vermont last Friday (4-1) and Saturday (1-0). WHEA Player of the Week Jenna Ouellette (Winnipeg, Man.) exploded with a five-point (1g,4a) week for Maine in the pair of victories vs. the Catamounts. Maine most recently played Union in a series last December, the Black Bears came away with a win and tie at Alfond Arena.

The Wildcats own a 31-12-4 all-time record against Dartmouth and has won each of the last two games in the series, an 8-3 win at the Whittemore Center last January and a 3-1 win at Thompson Arena in January 2008. UNH owns a 4-1-1 record in the last six meetings between the two schools. Senior forward Micaela Long (South Boston, Mass.) has 14 points (3g,11a) during her current nine-game point-scoring streak. She recorded her 100th career point Dec. 5 with a goal vs. Providence. UNH, who owns a 5-1-3 record in non-league play this year, will close out their non-conference schedule for the season on Saturday vs. the Big Green.
