## PROVIDENCE CAPTURES REGULAR-SEASON CHAMPIONSHIP ON SATURDAY ~Northeastern takes four points from UConn; BU sweeps Maine; BC, UNH split~

**WAKEFIELD, Mass.** – The 2010 WHEA Tournament bracket is set and the 8th Annual WHEA Tournament will be hosted by the Providence Friars on March 6th and 7th at Schneider Arena. Providence clinched the WHEA regular season title this weekend with a sweep over Vermont. UNH and BC split their final series of the season, while Northeastern blasted past UConn earning four critical points and the home ice advantage. Boston University swept Maine in the final two games of the season.

Providence traveled up north to Vermont for their last regular season series sweeping the Catamounts. The Friars picked up four points and earned their regular season WHEA title in school history with the weekend sweep. On Friday, WHEA Player of the Week Jean O'Neill (Strafford, Pa.) scored twice for the Friars for a 4-2 win. The story was the same on Saturday as Providence skated to a 5-2 victory. O'Neill led the way for the Friars again adding another goal and two assists bringing her point total to five on the weekend (3g, 2a).

In their weekend series, BU topped Maine twice, first by a score of 3-1 on Saturday and then a 2-0 shutout on Sunday. Maine jumped to an early one-goal lead on Saturday but BU resurfaced with three unanswered goals, including back-to-back goals by Melissa Anderson (Langley, B.C.). Maine goaltender Brittany Ott (St. Clair Shores, Mich.) stopped 37 shots in net. In Sunday afternoon's regular-season finale, BU showed up play-off ready and held the Black Bears scoreless, 2-0 for Melissa Haber's (Toronto, Ont.) eighth career shutout.

In a preview of one of the quarterfinal matchups, Northeastern and UConn faced off in a home and home series. It was a battle of the Huskies on Friday as both goalies recorded shutouts in a scoreless overtime tie. UConn outshot Northeastern, 28-18, but the only shot that mattered was that of Northeastern's Kristi Kehoe (Bakersfield, Calif.) who netted the lone goal of the game in the third round of the shootout. On Sunday Northeastern netminder Leah Sulyma (Inuvik, N.W.T.) recorded another shutout, stopping 60 total shots on the weekend to earn Defensive Player of the Week honors. The two teams will meet again on Saturday in the quarterfinal round on Saturday at Matthews Arena as No. 4 seed NU meets No. 5 seed UConn (4pm).

BC showed up to play on Saturday afternoon at the Whittemore Center vs. No. 4 UNH. Third period goals by BC's Allie Thunstrom (Maplewood, Minn.) and Danielle Welch (Hastings, Minn.) lifted the Eagles to a 2-1 victory. UNH rebounded on Sunday with a 4-1 win Sunday night at Conte Forum. Seniors Kelly Paton (Woodstock, Ont.) and Micaela Long (South Boston, Mass.) led the way with four points apiece (1g, 3a), while freshman Kristina Lavoie (Fonthill, Ont.) chipped in with three points of her own, (2g, 1a). With the win, UNH finished the regular season in a three-way tie for second place in the WHEA standings and earned the No. 2 seed. BC finished the year as the No. 6 seed and will play No. 3 BU in the quarterfinals on Feb. 28 at Walter Brown Arena.

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** Boston College finishes the regular season 8-16-10 overall and 7-10-4-4 in conference play...The Eagles will take on arch-rival Boston University on Sunday, February 28 at 3:00 p.m. at Walter Brown Arena in Boston, Mass. in the opening round of the Women's Hockey East Tournament...BC is 1-2-1 against the Terriers this season, with the team's skating to a 1-1 tie in the most recent matchup: the Beanpot Consolation...the quarterfinal matchup will potentially mark senior Allie Thunstrom's (Maplewood, Minn.) 141st game with Boston College, which would put her in a tie with Maggie Taverna '08 for most games played by a BC student-athlete in the past decade...Thunstrom finished the regular season tied for fifth in Hockey East in points with 29 (22-7) and first in goals scored...Freshman Ashley Motherwell (St. Charles, Ill.) finished the season tied for sixth among first-year scorers with 19 points (5-14).

**Boston University:** The Terriers closed the season with a sweep of Maine to finish in a second-place tie in Hockey East, the program's best-ever finish in the league standings...Closing the regular season with a record of 14-8-12, BU will set a program record for fewest losses in a season...The Terriers are the third seed in the playoffs for the second season in a row and will host sixth-seeded BC on Sunday at Walter Brown Arena...Last season, the Eagles ended BU's season with a 3-2 win in the Hockey East semifinals...The Terriers are 2-1-1 against BC this season and split the two games at Brown Arena...After posting four points this weekend, senior Melissa Anderson has broken her own BU single-season record with 36 points this season...Senior Melissa Haber recorded her eighth career shutout on Sunday, setting a BU program record...BU enters the playoffs on a three-game winning streak and seven-game unbeaten streak.

**University of Connecticut:** For the second time this season in Hockey East action, UConn suffered a pair of shutout decisions favoring the opposition, including being held winless for the third-straight Senior Day on Saturday against No. 8/9 Northeastern. In a combined three games against Northeastern, the Huskies scored just one goal and allowed just three. In all three games, UConn outshot Northeastern with significant margins in the last two contests. The Huskies outshot the other Huskies 32-17 on Sunday. Despite the bitter end to the regular season, the Huskies secured their fourth-consecutive Hockey East Tournament bid.

**University of Maine:** Maine were defeated in their season series finale at Boston University on Saturday and Sunday afternoon. In Saturday's game, senior Abby Barton (Woodstock, N.H.) scored her 13th career goal in her final series in a Black Bear uniform...Freshman Brittany Ott (St. Clair Shores, Mich.) started in net for the Black Bears on Saturday and made 37 saves in the contest. It was the 11th time this season that Ott has recorded 30 or more saves in a game...Senior captain Amy Stech played in her 129th career game as a Black Bear on Sunday, missing only one game throughout her four years at Maine...The Black Bears improved this season, picking up one more victory overall than they did last season...Maine's PK unit was a high point for the team all season as they killed off 128 of 155 power plays, good for 83% and placing them in the top 15 in penalty kill nationally.

**University of New Hampshire:** UNH is the #2 seed in the 8th Annual Hockey East Championship tournament and will attempt to win the tourney for the fifth consecutive year...Kelly Paton became the fifth UNH Wildcat to reach the 100-assist milestone in a three-assist effort Feb. 21 at BC...Paton tied her career highs in both assists (three) and points (four) in that game...Also in that game, Micaela Long (South Boston, Mass.) matched her personal best of four points (1g, 3a) and Kristina Lavoie (Fonthill, Ont.) equaled her career highs in both goals (two) and points (three)...Paton, Long and Courtney Birchard (Mississauga, Ont.) are among the 45 nominees for the 2010 Patty Kazmaier Memorial Award...The senior class of Long, Paton, Kelly Cahill (Farmington Hills, Mich.) and Shannon Sisk (Pipersville, Pa.) were honored prior to the final regular-season home game at the Whittemore Center on Feb. 20; the quartet has won 104 games in four years.

**Northeastern University:** Northeastern allowed one goal vs. UConn in three games this season. Since UConn scored vs. NU on Oct. 4, Northeastern has kept the other Huskies scoreless for over 179 consecutive minutes...Northeastern's win over UConn on Sunday was its 500th program victory...Northeastern has allowed two goals or fewer in each of the last six games. The Huskies rank second in the nation in scoring defense (1.47 goals per game)...In seven shootouts this season, the Huskies have outscored opponents, 9-3, including 8-0 in five shootout wins. Netminders Leah Sulyma (7/8) and Florence Schelling (19/21) have stopped 26 of 29 shootout attempts overall...Five players finished the regular season with 20+ points for the first time since the 1999-00 squad (seven players had 20+ points).

**Providence College:** Providence swept UVM this past weekend to earn its third Hockey East regular season championship and first outright title since 2002-03...The Friars had 12 different players tally points this weekend as seven players scored goals...PC scored nine goals in a weekend for the first time since January 9-10 against No. 8 Cornell...PC held a +17 edge in scoring in the first and second periods combined in 2009-10...Providence finished the regular season with 9 ties, the most in program history...The Friars allowed 25 power-play goals this season, the fewest since PC allowed only 22 in 2002-03...Genevieve Lacasse (Scarborough, Ont.) finished the regular season as PC's single-season saves leader with 858.

**University of Vermont:** Vermont closed out the 2009-10 season with two losses to Providence at home...Senior Chelsea Furlani (Colchester, Vt.) found the back of the net on Friday for her 25th career goal...Her 25 goals are now the most all time at the Division I level for a Catamount...Senior Brittany Nelson (Shelburne, Vt.) finished her career third all time at the Division I level in points scored with 39 points...Senior goalie Kristen Olychuck recorded 22 wins during her time in Burlington, which is a Division I record at the school...Freshman Erin Wente finished her rookie season on a tear finding the back of the net in both games over the weekend...She finished her rookie campaign with nine points off of six goals and three assists...Vermont graduates five players from this year's team.
