2010 WHEA CHAMPIONSHIP FIELD SET FOR MARCH 6-7 AT PROVIDENCE ~Boston U. and Connecticut advance from Quarterfinal Round~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – In the first round of the WHEA quarterfinals, No. 5 seed UConn knocked off No. 4 Northeastern advancing to the WHEA semifinals for the fourth consecutive season, while No. 3 Boston University defeated No. 6 Boston College, earning themselves another trip to WHEA semifinals for the third consecutive year.

Connecticut jumped to an early three-goal lead in the first period at Matthews Arena and defeated Northeastern by a score of 4-1. UConn got on the board in the first period with a goal from Kelly Horan (Methuen, Mass.) followed ten seconds later by a goal from Brittany Murphy (Tewksbury, Mass.) and a third goal a minute later from Elisabeth Stathopoulos (Toronto, Ont.). Northeastern was looking to build off a strong performance in goal by Leah Sulyma who posted back-to-back shutouts against UConn the previous weekend but UConn came out strong fighting to continue their post season resume. Florence Schelling (Oberengstringen, Switz.) returned from the Olympics and was back between the pipes splitting time in goal with Sulyma, they combined for 17 saves. UConn will make their sixth appearance in the WHEA tournament on Saturday.

Across town, Boston University skated to a 3-1 victory over their rival Boston College. The terriers were led by Lauren Cherewyk (St. Albert, Alb.) and freshman Jill Cardella (Rochester, N.Y.) who both tallied a goal and an assist in the victory. With the win, the Terriers extended their winning streak to four games. Danielle Welch (Hastings, Minn.) was the only Eagle to find the back of the net scoring BC's lone goal in the first period while Kiera Kingston (Trumbull, Conn.) stopped 28 shots in the loss.

The WHEA championship field is now set for this coming weekend, Saturday, March 6th and Sunday, March 7th at Schneider Arena hosted by Providence College. The No. 1 seed Providence will face off against Connecticut Saturday at noon, followed by the second semifinal, which will feature No. 2 New Hampshire vs. BU at 3pm. The tournament will be a mirror image of the 2008 semifinal matchups. Both WHEA semifinals games will be broadcast live on the internet by B2 Networks at www.b2livetv.com.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: Boston College finishes the 2009-10 season 8-17-10 overall, after dropping a 3-1 matchup to Boston University in the quarterfinals of the Hockey East Tournament...senior Allie Thunstrom finishes her BC career with 86 goals and 52 assists for 138 points in 141 games...she is the fourth leading scorer in BC's history as well as third on the all-time goals list and tied for ninth on the all-time assists list...along with Thunstrom, seniors Tracy Johnson and Shannon Webster combined for 401 games played, 96 goals, 78 assists and 174 points during their time at the Heights.

Boston University: The Terriers advanced to the Hockey East semifinals for the third straight season with a 3-1 win over Boston College...BU will be seeking its first ever trip to the conference championship game after falling to BC in last year's semis and New Hampshire in 2008...Third-seeded BU will face second-seeded New Hampshire...The Terriers and Wildcats finished tied in the league standings and split the season series 1-1-1 with BU winning the shootout after the tie...Sophomore Jenelle Kohanchuk (Winnipeg, Man.) returned to the lineup after missing 10 games due to injury and tallied an assist. Kohanchuk now has four points (2g,2a) in three career postseason games...The Terriers have won four straight games and are unbeaten in their last eight games...BU has scored five power-play goals in the last four games and has been perfect on the penalty kill in the last three games.

University of Connecticut: Secured a spot in the Hockey East Tournament Semifinal with a 4-1 victory over No. 7/8 Northeastern on Saturday, winning against the other Huskies for the first time after going 0-1-2 in the regular season. Scored three goals in less than a minute and half on Leah Sulyma after being shutting out by the Northeastern defense during the final series of the regular season series. Kelly Horan (Methuen, Mass.) and fellow rookies Casey Knajdek (Woodbury, Minn.) and Elisabeth Stathopoulos (Toronto, Ont.) combined for the first goal of the game and Stathopoulos netted the final of three in the scoring spree on Saturday. Stathopoulos led the Huskies with a goal and an assist while it was the balanced effort of 10 different players making it on the stat sheet to five Connecticut its second 20-or-more win season in last three. UConn now owns a 2-5 record in the Hockey East Tournament and advances to the semifinal after winning the first-ever postseason meeting with the other Huskies. Saturday's game against Providence will be the fourth Hockey East Tournament meeting between the two teams.

University of New Hampshire: UNH enters the 8th Annual Women's Hockey East Championship tournament with eight consecutive victories in the tourney by virtue of winning four consecutive titles...The Wildcats have a 10-3 lifetime record in the WHEA tourney; the record breakdown is 6-1 in the semifinals and 4-2 in the final...UNH has a 17-2-3 lifetime record against its semifinal opponent, BU; that includes 1-1-1 this season and 1-0 in the league tourney (2008 semifinal, 8-0)...Lindsey Minton (Richardson, Texas) started the last five games of the regular season and compiled a 4-1-0 record with a 1.12 GAA and .950 save percentage...Both Micaela Long (South Boston, Mass.) and Kelly Paton recorded 12 points in the last five games; Long has two goals and 10 assists in that span while Paton tallied five goals and seven assists...In the last five games, UNH's power play went 7-for-16 (43.8%).

Northeastern University: Five different players set new personal bests for points in a single season in 2009-10: Lindsay Berman (Odenton, Md.) posted 20 points, Kristi Kehoe (Bakersfield, Calif.) tallied 26, Lori Antflick (Thornhill, Ontario) registered six, Annie Hogan (Medford, Mass.) racked up 20, and Kasey Cedarchuk (Stoneham, Mass.) posted six...Four players scored 10+ goals for Northeastern for the first time since the 1999-00 squad (five players scored 10+ goals)...Junior Kristi Kehoe (Bakersfield, Calif.) led the team in scoring for the third straight year...Four Huskies (Kristi Kehoe, Lindsay Berman, Kelly Wallace, Stephanie Gavronsky) were a +11 this season; no Northeastern player has registered a +11 rating since Amy Goodney accomplished the feat during the 2003-04 season...Northeastern allowed only one power-play goal during the month of February, killing off 26 of 27 power plays...The Huskies finished the regular season/playoffs with a 91.1% penalty kill rate. This represents this highest mark since the '99-00 squad's 91.4% penalty-killing rate...Northeastern allowed only 51 goals during the season, the lowest mark in eight years among NU teams (2001-02 team allowed 47).

Providence College: The Friars will face No. 5 seed UConn in the semifinals of the Hockey East Tournament on Saturday at 12:00 p.m...The Friars have ended the Huskies' season in four of the seven years since the league was created in 2002-03...Providence lost the season series to Connecticut (0-1-2) but owns a 26-8-4 record in the all-time series...Providence defeated UConn in both shootouts this season...The Friars own a combined record of 92-85-17 all-time against the three teams playing this weekend...Junior forward Alyse Ruff (Tualatin, Ore.) leads the Friars with eight points on four goals and four assists in 11 career games against UConn...Junior forward Jean O'Neill (Strafford, Pa.) finished the year with 29 points on 13 goals and 16 assists after recording 12 goals and 13 assists in her first two seasons at Providence College...Goalender Genevieve Lacasse (Scarborough, Ont.) has been outstanding against UConn in her two seasons at PC...In seven career games against the Huskies, Lacasse owns a 3-2-2 record with two shutouts, including a 3-0 shutout in the 2009 Hockey East quarterfinals...She's recorded a 1.52 GAA and a .945 save percentage...Providence will look to reach the finals of the Hockey East Tournament for the sixth time in eight seasons and earn its fourth Hockey East Championship.
