### HOCKEY EAST HEADLINES

Providence was the lone team to secure all six Hockey East points available to them last weekend, sweeping a two-game road set at Vermont.

**Patrick Moynihan** registered three power-play goals while **Jaxson Stauber** stopped 59-of-62 shots faced, including a 22-save shutout on Saturday night.

New Hampshire earned a weekend split with #8 Massachusetts after a thrilling 2-1 overtime victory on Saturday night. **Jackson Pierson** netted the game-winning goal just 37 seconds into overtime to deliver the victory while **Mike Robinson** made 32 saves and only allowed one goal for a .970 save percentage.

Northeastern moved into a tie for third place in the Army ROTC Hockey East Standings after a 1-0-1 weekend. **Devon Levi** posted his fifth shutout of the season with a 38-save performance at Boston University on Friday night. The win moved him into first in the NCAA in shutouts this season and also tied Northeastern's single-season shutout record.

**Andre Lee** extended his scoring streak to three consecutive games with three points across the River Hawks' weekend split with UConn. He opened the weekend with two goals, including the game-winning goal, in UMass Lowell's 3-0 win over the Huskies. ## PRO AMBITIONS ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

### DEVON LEVI NORTHEASTERN

**Devon Levi** (So., G; Dollard-des-Ormeaux, Que.) went 1-0-1 on the weekend, including his fifth shutout of the season with a 38-save performance at Boston University on Friday night. The win moved him into first in the NCAA in shutouts this season and also tied Northeastern's single-season shutout record. He is already tied for fifth on Northeastern's career shutouts list after just 14 games. He followed it up with a 33-save night in a 2-2 tie against BU before the Huskies won in a shootout in eight rounds.

**Mike Robinson** (Sr., G; Bedford, N.H.) made 32 saves and only allowed one goal for a .970 save percentage in a 2-1 overtime win over #8 UMass on Saturday, Nov. 20.



## HOCKEY EAST WEEKLY TOP PERFORMERS

**Jack McBain, BC** (Sr., F; Toronto, Ont.) Scored his first career hat trick on Thursday night in a 6-2 victory over Maine. He increased his league-leading point total to 19 on the season on nine goals and 10 assists in 14 games played.

**Jack St. Ivany, BC** (Sr., D; Manhattan Beach, Calif.) Posted a goal and two assists in a two-game series against Maine. He lifted his point total to 13 to lead all Hockey East defensemen, and was plus-three on Thursday night in a 6-2 victory.

**Brandon Kruse, BC** (Gr., F; Saline, Mich.) Had three primary assists on Thursday in a 6-2 win over Maine to extend his point streak to seven games.

**Darion Hanson, UC** (Gr., G; East Bethel, Minn.) Went 1-1-0 on the weekend, making 51 saves on 54 shots faced. In Saturday's loss he stopped 21 shots in a 3-0 road loss and then came back on Sunday to stop 30, including a clean sheet with 11 saves in the 3rd period to keep the Huskies' 2-1 lead intact for the win.

**Andre Lee, UML** (Jr., F; Karlstad, Sweden) Extended his scoring streak to three consecutive games with three points across the River Hawks' two-game series with UConn. He opened the weekend with two goals, including the game-winning goal, in UMass Lowell's 3-0 win over the Huskies. Found his way back onto the score sheet on Sunday, scoring an unassisted breakaway goal in the River Hawks' 2-1 loss to UConn. Finished the weekend with a plus-one rating. Leads the team in points with 10 off eight goals and two assists ... Leads the team in game-winning goals with three. Tied for first in the conference and fifth in the country in game-winning goals.

**Owen Savory, UML** (Sr., G; Cambridge, Ont.) Led the River Hawks to a weekend split over the UConn Huskies, finishing with 52 saves and just two goals allowed. Opened the weekend with a 3-0 shutout against the Huskies to register his second shutout of the season and eighth of his career. Made a season-high 34 stops on Saturday and made 18 saves Sunday. Ranks second in the country in both GAA (1.24) and save percentage (.947) ... Leads the conference in GAA and ranks second in save percentage.

**Liam Devlin, UNH** (Fr., F; Needham, Mass.) Scored the first goal of the game in a 2-1 overtime win over #8 UMass on Saturday.

**Jackson Pierson, UNH** (Sr., F; Zionsville, Ind.) Netted the game-winning goal just 37 seconds into overtime to deliver UNH a victory over #8 UMass.

**Aidan McDonough, NU** (Jr., F; Milton, Mass.) Scored all three of Northeastern's goals in a 1-0-1 weekend to move into a tie for third in the NCAA and the Hockey East lead with 11 goals this season. He scored the overtime winner at Boston University on Friday night before potting a pair the following night at Matthews Arena in come-from-behind fashion.

**Cody Monds, PC** (Fr., F; Brockville, Ont.) Picked up three points over two games this weekend at Vermont, including an assist and the game-winning goal with 6:00 left in Friday night's 4-3 win. Monds also assisted on Parker Ford's game-winning goal in Saturday night's 2-0 win.

**Jaxson Stauber, PC** (Jr., G; Plymouth, Minn.) Stopped 59-of-62 shots faced over two victories this weekend. On Friday, Stauber made 37 saves and followed that up with a 22-save shutout on Saturday night. He finished with a 1.50 GAA and .952 save percentage over two games this weekend.

## NEWS & NOTES

The Hockey East schedule enters the Thanksgiving break with only one conference game on the slate until December 3. A heavy non-league schedule gives the league its best chance to improve its out of conference record, currently sitting two games below .500 at 23-21-4.

Due to COVID-19 protocols and out of an abundance of caution, Boston College has postponed its games against Notre Dame this Friday, Nov. 26 and Harvard next Tuesday, Nov. 30.

New Hampshire claimed a 2-1 overtime win at home over #8 UMass on Saturday. The Wildcats are 2-0-1 in overtime this season. UNH is 5-2-1 at the Whittemore Center.

#15 UMass Lowell and Maine duel on Saturday, Nov. 27 at Cross Insurance Arena in Portland, Maine. Puck drop is set for 5:00 p.m.

Red Hot Hockey returns to Madison Square Garden on Saturday, November 27. The Kelley-Harkness Cup will be up for grabs for the first time since 2019. Red Hot Hockey has become one of the premier events in college hockey since debuting in 2007 as over half of the previous Red Hot Hockey games have been played in front of sold-out crowds at Madison Square Garden.

BU went undefeated in the first five Red Hot Hockey meetings (3-0-2), but Cornell has won each of the past two, including a 2-0 decision in 2019 for the first shutout in the event's history. BU won in 2007, 2011 and 2013 while the rivals skated to ties in 2009 and 2015. The Kelley-Harkness Cup, which honors legendary coaches Jack Kelley (BU) and Ned Harkness (Cornell), was first introduced eight years ago.
