Massachusetts Repeats as Tournament Champions

Minutemen, UMass Lowell, Northeastern Earn NCAA Bids

HOCKEY EAST HEADLINES

Massachusetts repeated as Hockey East Men's Tournament Champions, toppling UMass Lowell, 3-1, in the semifinals and earning a 2-1 overtime victory over UConn in the title contest.

The Minutemen become the first to repeat as champions since UMass Lowell in 2013 and 2014. **Bobby Trivigno** was named the MVP of the Hockey East playoff for the second straight season, joining River Hawks goaltender **Connor Hellebuyck** as only the second player to ever win the Bill Flynn Award twice.

UConn appeared in the Hockey East title game for the first time in program history. **Vladislav Firstov** and **John Spetz** were named to the Steze Nazro All Tournament Team, while goaltender **Darion Hanson** was the runner up for the MVP.

Three Hockey East teams will compete in the NCAA Tournament, including UMass, UMass Lowell, and Northeastern. The selections bring Hockey East's total representation in the national tournament to 121 teams over the history of the conference, more than any other league over that span.

Massachusetts and Northeastern will both compete in the Worcester Regional while UMass Lowell travels to Loveland, Colorado. All three Hockey East semifinalists are vying for the opportunity to return to TD Garden for the 2022 Frozen Four, which will be hosted by Hockey East on April 7 & 9.

HOCKEY EAST PLAYER OF THE WEEK

BOBBY TRIVIGNO MASSACHUSETTS

Bobby Trivigno (Sr., F; Setauket, N.Y.) was named to the Hockey East All-Tournament Team and was the Tournament MVP for a second-straight year after helping UMass to back-to-back Hockey East Tournament titles with a three-point weekend on two goals and an assist. Scored the game winner in Friday's 3-1 Semifinal victory on Friday vs. UMass Lowell and followed up by factoring in both goals in Saturday's championship, tying the score at 1-1 with his 20th goal of the year and setting up the game winner in overtime for his 48th point of the season.



PRO AMBITIONS ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

CHASE BRADLEY UCONN

Chase Bradley (Fr., F; St. Louis, Mo.) dished out two assists, racked up five shots on goal, and finished with a plus-three rating in two games during the Hockey East Championship weekend at TD Garden. Bradley's helpers came on the first two goals in UConn's 4-1 semifinal win, assisting the Huskies into the Hockey East title game for the first time in program history.



HOCKEY EAST DEFENDER OF THE WEEK

AARON BOHLINGER MASSACHUSETTS

Aaron Bohlinger (So., D; Walden, N.Y.) scored the game-winning goal in overtime to deliver UMass its second consecutive Hockey East Tournament crown. Bohlinger finished the weekend with a plus-two rating, one shot on goal, one game-winning goal.



HOCKEY EAST GOALTENDER OF THE WEEK

MATT MURRAY MASSACHUSETTS

Matt Murray (Gr., G; St. Albert, Alta.) was named to the Hockey East All-Tournament Team after stopping 41 of 43 shots for a .953 save percentage and let up just two goals in 123:06 of game action for a 0.98 goals against average for the week, helping UMass to its second straight Hockey East Tournament title. He earned two victories to move his total to 21 on the year, breaking his own UMass record of 20, set in 2018-19. He had 22 saves in Friday's 3-1 semifinal victory and followed up with 19 stops in a 2-1 overtime win over UConn in the Hockey East Championship.



HOCKEY EAST WEEKLY TOP PERFORMERS

Darion Hanson, UConn (Gr., G; Bethel, Minn.) Allowed only three goals and stopped 55 shots in two outings last weekend, lifting UConn to the Hockey East title game for the first time in program history. Hanson finished second in the voting for the Hockey East Tournament MVP, having stopped 93 shots in three playoff games.

Vladislav Firstov, UConn (Jr., F; Yaroslavl, Russia) Named to the Steve Nazro All-Tournament Team, Firstov scored two goals last weekend in the Hockey East Championship weekend. Both of his strikes opened the game's scoring. He finished with a goal in all three of UConn's Hockey East Tournament games.

John Spetz, UConn (So., D; Oak Ridge, N.J.) Named to the Steve Nazro All-Tournament Team, Spetz assisted on the lone UConn goal in the Hockey East title game. In two games last weekend, he fired six shots on net and finished with a plus-two rating.

Colin Felix, UMass (Sr., D; Ocean City, N.J.) Joining his teammates on the Steve Nazro All-Tournament Team, Felix assisted on the game-tying goal in the Hockey East title game.

Garrett Wait, UMass (Sr., F; Edina, Minn.) Was named to the Steve Nazro All-Tournament Team after scoring a goal and adding an assist in two games at TD Garden last weekend. He fired five shots on net and finished with a plus-three rating.

NEWS & NOTES

Hockey East will be represented in the 2022 NCAA Division I Men's Ice Hockey Tournament by three member programs that include Massachusetts, UMass Lowell, and Northeastern, the NCAA announced today. Regional play begins Thursday, March 24 while the 2022 Frozen Four will be hosted by Hockey East at TD Garden in Boston on April 7 and 9.

Massachusetts, the reigning 2021 National Champion and two-time defending Hockey East Tournament champion, enters the National Tournament the third consecutive time and fourth in program history. UMass claimed the NCAA crown last season in Pittsburgh after a runner-up finish in 2019 in Buffalo. Massachusetts draws a date with Minnesota in Worcester, Massachusetts on Friday, March 25 at 6:00 p.m. and owns a record of 8-2 in the national postseason tournament.

Northeastern joins their Hockey East rivals in Worcester and will play the third-overall seed Western Michigan Friday at 12:00 p.m. The Huskies return to the National Tournament for the first time since 2019 and own a 1-6-0 record in six prior tournament appearances as a member of Hockey East.

UMass Lowell rounds out a trio of Hockey East teams vying for the 2022 NCAA title, traveling to Loveland, Colorado to take on Denver at 9:00 p.m. ET. The River Hawks have earned a berth in the National Tournament for the first time since 2017, taking an all-time 8-8-1 record into the postseason. The team made it all the way to the Frozen Four in 2014.
