Connors, Hutson, Terness Tabbed as Top Rookie, Defender, and Goaltender



Hockey East Player of the Month **Ryan Tverberg - UConn**

Junior Forward; Richmond Hills, Ont.

Ryan Tverberg played a vital role for the Huskies over the past month, helping UConn to the best start in program history at 7-1-1. The junior scored seven goals and added four assists for 11 points, including three power-play goals and one game-winning strike. He led Hockey East with 11 overall points and seven goals and recorded at least one point in all but one of UConn's nine games.

He led UMass in scoring in a 5-1-1 month $\ ^{2}$ with nine points over seven games on three goals and six assists, 22 including two power-play goals, one shorthanded tally and one 28 game winner and was plus-three. He also blocked seven shots 29 and won 44 faceoffs.
