Hockey East Names 2022-23 Men's All-Star Teams

League Honors Three All-Star Teams During 38th Tournament Celebration

AMESBURY, Mass. - The Hockey East Association today announced its 2022-23 Men's All-Star Teams as voted by the league's 11 head coaches as part of the celebration of the 38th Hockey East Men's Tournament presented by Movement Mortgage.

The All-Hockey East First Team is highlighted by two unanimous selections, including Northeastern junior goaltender **Devon Levi** (Dollard-des-Ormeaux, Que.) and Boston University freshman defenseman **Lane Hutson** (North Barrington, Ill.). Joining the pair on the First Team are defenseman **Domenick Fensore** (Thornwood, N.Y./Boston University) and forwards **Matt Brown** (Wood Ridge, N.J./Boston University), **Alex Jefferies** (Lunenburg, Mass./Merrimack), and **Aidan McDonough** (Milton, Mass./Northeastern). Levi was also named Stop It Goaltending Goaltender of the Year, the second straight year he has been so honored.

Named to the All-Hockey East Second Team are goaltenders **Victor Ostman** (Danderyd, Sweden/Maine), a pair of Massachusetts defensemen **Scott Morrow** (Darien, Conn.) and **Ryan Ufko** (Long Island, N.Y.), and forwards **Lynden Breen** (Grand Bay-Westfield, N.B./Maine), **Justin Hryckowian** (L'Île-Bizard, Que./Northeastern) and **Ryan Tverberg** (Richmond Hill, Ont./UConn).

Getting nods on the All-Star Third Team are goaltenders **Gustavs Davis Grigals** (Riga, Latvia/UMass Lowell) and **Hugo Ollas** (Linköping, Sweden/Merrimack), defenders **Max Crozier** (Calgary, Alta./Providence) and **Jon McDonald** (Livonia, Mich./UMass Lowell), and forwards **Cutter Gauthier** (Scottsdale, Ariz./Boston College), **Parker Ford** (Wakefield, R.I./Providence), and **Wilmer Skoog** (Tyresö, Sweden/Boston University).

Hockey East will announce finalists for the Player, Rookie, and Coach of the Year awards on Monday, March 13.

The 2023 Hockey East Men's Tournament presented by Movement Mortgage continues with the quarterfinals on March 11 to take on Boston University, Merrimack, and Northeastern, while UMass Lowell at UConn is slated for a 4:00 p.m. start.

The Hockey East semifinals are set tentatively set for 4:00pm and 7:30pm on Friday, March 17 at TD Garden in Boston, while the 38th championship game will be played Saturday, March 18 at 7:00pm.
