Tickets to the 2025 Hockey East Men's Championship on Sale Monday

League Tournament Championship Returns to TD Garden March 20-21

AMESBURY, Mass. – Tickets for the 2025 Hockey East Men's Championship, set for Thursday and Friday, March 20-21, 2025 at the TD Garden in Boston will go on sale Monday, December 2. All tickets will available to purchase online at Ticketmaster.com.

Fans can save 10% when buying tickets for both dates as part of a special Cyber Monday promotion. After a sold out event in 2024, Hockey East strongly recommends that fans purchase tickets in advance to avoid missing college hockey's most prestigious postseason tournament after a sell out in 2024.

Hockey East Tournament semifinal games will take place Thursday, March 20 at 4:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. and semifinal tickets include admission to both semifinal contests. The two winners will advance to the Hockey East title game set for Friday, March 21, to determine the winner of the Lamoriello Trophy and the league's automatic qualifier into the NCAA Tournament.

Tickets will become available to participating semifinalist campuses when the four teams are identified following the quarterfinals on March 15. Student tickets will also be made available at that time.

ABOUT THE HOCKEY EAST ASSOCIATION

The Hockey East Association is an 11-team Division I college men's hockey conference founded in 1984 and a 10-team Division I women's league which began play in 2002-03. The men's league has won 10 NCAA championships, most recently in 2021. Since 1999, Hockey East has won eight men's NCAA Championships with 18 NCAA Championship Game appearances, while placing 31 teams in the Frozen Four and 83 teams in the NCAA Tournament. Overall, Hockey East has sent 127 teams to the men's NCAA Tournament since its inaugural season, more than any other conference in that span. Hockey East is home to 12 Hobey Baker winners and four Patty Kazmaier winners.
