

ST. LOUIS INDUCTED INTO HALL

- Former Catamount great Martin St. Louis received his induction call to the NHL Hall of Fame in June 2018
- On Monday, Nov. 12, 2018, St. Louis was officially inducted to the Hockey Hall of Fame in Toronto.
- St. Louis was one of six members of the Class of 2018 inducted. He joined NHL Commissioner Gary Bettman, Willie O’Ree, Martin Brodeur, Jayna Hefford, and Alexander Yakushev in hockey immortality.
- Almost seven years ago, prior to the Jan. 8, 2016 win over Dartmouth at the Gut, the men’s hockey program honored its all-time leading scorer at center ice on Martin St. Louis Night.
- For the first time in program history, the Catamounts retired a jersey number and raised St. Louis’ No. 8 to the rafters during a pre-game ceremony, never to be worn again by another player.
- A three-time NCAA All-American, St. Louis ’97 registered 267 career points and helped lead the Catamounts to their first-ever NCAA Frozen Four berth in 1996 in Cincinnati.
- The Tampa Bay Lightning’s all-time leading scorer (953 points) had his No. 26 jersey retired by the franchise on Jan. 13, 2017 when the Lightning hosted his former NHL head coach John Tortorella and the Columbus Blue Jackets at AMALIE Arena.


MAJOR NHL AWARDS
