UConn Sweeps Boston University, Off to Best Ever Start

UConn continued its best start to a season, improving to 10-1-0 with a pair of victories over Boston University. **Samantha Carpentier-Yelle** stopped 42 of 43 shots she faced, improving her personal mark to 8-1-0. The Terriers were previously undefeated in league play. On Saturday, Carpentier-Yelle pitched a 15-save shutout, her second of the season.

Northeastern claimed five points in league play over top-contender Providence with a 5-1 win on Friday before earning an extra point with a shootout win after a 1-1 draw on Saturday. **Alina Mueller**, in her return to the Husky lineup since an off-season injury, scored three points on one goal and two assists, helping Northeastern to a 5-1 win at Providence. She fired eight shots on net across the two games, while going 29-6 at the faceoff dot.

Aerin Frankel broke yet another Northeastern program record this weekend stopping 62 of 64 shots faced against Providence in a 1-0-1 weekend. With her 62 saves, she surpassed the mark of 2,808 career saves, the old program record set in 2015 by Chloe Desjardins, raising the bar to 2,812 saves, and counting. She is now 432 saves away from setting a new career saves record in Hockey East play, having stopped 1,893 in conference action.

In Saturday's contest, the program leader for defender points hit another milestone when she tallied her 50th career goal with 0.9 seconds left on the clock in the first period, on the power play. She finished the weekend with a team-high five (1g, 4a) points and seven blocked shots.

HOCKEY EAST GOALTENDER OF THE WEEK

AERIN FRANKEL NORTHEASTERN

Aerin Frankel (Gr., G; Briarcliff Manor, N.Y.) broke yet another Northeastern program record this weekend stopping 62 of 64 shots faced against Providence in a 1-0-1 weekend. With her 62 saves, she surpassed the mark of 2,808 career saves, the old program record set in 2015 by Chloe Desjardins, raising the bar to 2,812 saves, and counting. Frankel posted a 0.96 GAA and .969 save percentage in her undefeated weekend, and also stonewalled two penalty shot attempts in the game two shootout, allowing the Huskies to pick up the extra point, 2-0. She is now 432 saves away from setting a new career saves record in Hockey East play, having stopped 1,893 in conference action.

Samantha Carpentier-Yelle, UConn (Sr., G; Bromont, Que.) Stopped 42 of 43 shots she faced from Boston University over the weekend, earning two wins for UConn and improving to 8-1-0 on the season and pushing the Huskies to 10-1-0 overall. The Terriers were previously undefeated in league play. On Saturday, Carpentier-Yelle pitched a 15-save shutout, her second of the season.

Natalie Snodgrass, UConn (Gr., G; Eagan, Minn.) Netted the lone goal, an unassisted tally, in UConn's 1-0 victory on the road at Boston University on Saturday.

Allison Reeb, MC (Jr., F; Bellingham, Wash.) Picked up two points, one goal and one assist, to help Merrimack earn its third consecutive win with a 5-3 victory over Holy Cross.

NEWS & NOTES

Boston College and Harvard renew their rivalry as the two ranked opponents meet on Tuesday in Cambridge. The Eagles and Crimson are both ranked in the top-10 nationally, with just two losses for each. The Eagles then clash with Providence for a pair of games on Friday and Saturday. In 2020-21, Boston College toppled Providence twice by a combined score of 12-0 and have won three in a row against the Friars.

UConn looks to extend its program-best start of 10-1-0 this weekend, welcoming Maine to Storrs for a pair of league contests. Last year, the teams met just once, a 3-0 UConn victory on Feb. 5. The Huskies are 5-1-1 against the Black Bears since 2018-19.

Northeastern travels to Vermont as the Huskies have won each of the last 13 meetings with the Catamounts, including two playoff series in 2018 and 2019. **Alina Mueller**, in her return to the Husky lineup since an off-season injury, scored three points on one goal and two assists, helping Northeastern to a 5-1 win at Providence last Friday. She fired eight shots on net across the two games, while going 29-6 at the faceoff dot.

Boston University and Holy Cross clash for the first of three times in 2021-22 on Thursday and Friday. It will be the first meeting between the two programs since BU swept the Crusaders in 2019-20 as the pair did not meet during the COVID-shortened 2020-21 campaign. The Terriers have won all six of the contests with Holy Cross since the 2018-19 season when the Crusaders joined Hockey East.

The UNH Wildcats are currently riding a three-game unbeaten streak (2-0-1) into next weekend's series vs. Merrimack. New Hampshire will honor alum and three-time Olympian **Kacey Bellamy** on Saturday, Nov. 13 with Kacey Bellamy Day. Bellamy, who announced her retirement from USA Hockey this past summer, will be recognized for her exemplary career with Team USA. Fans will have the opportunity to meet Bellamy during the first intermission autograph session.
