HOCKEY EAST HEADLINES

Vermont earned its first victory over Boston College since 2009 on Friday night, taking a 3-1 decision from the Eagles. **Jessie McPherson** made 15 saves in the win, which moved the reigning Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Year to 4-3-0 on the year with a .907 save percentage and 2.04 goals against average. First-year forward **Evelyne Blais-Savoie** scored the game-winning strike, ending the first half of the year with points in three of her last four outings, including two tallies, and two Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Week titles in the last three weeks.

Holy Cross ended the first half with a 4-2 win over Brown Friday night. **Carlie Magier** became the first Crusader to enjoy a multi-goal outing this season as the senior forward found the back of the net twice, including the game-winning strike. **Kailey Langefels** dished out a pair of helpers, entering the break by scoring her first two points of the year. She also anchored a Crusader defense by blocking five shots on the night.

The women's league will now enter the holiday break, resuming play on Dec. 31 when Vermont visits Providence at 1:00pm in a game on NESN. League play begins in earnest the following weekend with five league contests on Friday, Jan. 7 and Saturday, Jan. 8.
