Vermont's Theresa Schafzahl Named Hockey East Player of the Year

Boston College's Newhook, Catamounts' Plumer Named Top Rookie and Coach of 2021-22

AMESBURY, Mass. - The Hockey East Association announced today that Vermont senior forward **Theresa Schafzahl** (Weiz, Austria) has been awarded the 2022 Cammi Granato Award as Hockey East Player of the Year. Schafzahl is the first Vermont Catamount to be so honored.

Alongside Schafzahl, Vermont head coach **Jim Plumer** was unanimously named Hockey East Coach of the Year, his second time winning the award, while Boston College forward **Abby Newhook** (St. John's, N.L.) was tabbed Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Year.

Schafzahl appeared in 21 regular season games in Hockey East play for Vermont, leading the conference with 21 goals, 39 points, and a plus-28 on-ice rating. Her 1.86 points per game was second-best among all league players, while her 97 shots on goal ranked sixth. She netted three game-winning goals in league play and converted at a shooting rate of 21.6%. The Weiz, Austria, native potted seven of her 21 tallies while on the power-play, ranking second in the conference. Schafzahl was crowned the Hockey East Scoring Champion and PNC Bank Three Stars Award Winner, as well as the sole unanimous First Team All-Hockey East selection. She was named Hockey East Player of the Week four times and Hockey East and National Player of the Month in January, was the runner-up in February, and was the lone unanimous selection to the All-Hockey East First Team.

Newhook led Hockey East rookies in nearly every offensive category in 2021-22, including goals (13), assists (12), points (25), points per game (0.96), game-winning goals (5), and plus/minus (plus-17). She was named Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Week six times, including on back-to-back occasions twice and three out of four weeks once and Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Month three times. No freshman in the NCAA was more clutch than Newhook this year, as the first-year forward scored six game-winning goals in all games, more than any other rookie in the nation. She enjoyed a stretch of eight straight games with a goal, finding the back of the net in every outing from January 21 - February 8. She was named to the Pro Ambitions All-Rookie Team by a unanimous vote of the league's 10 head coaches.

Plumer, named Hockey East Coach of the Year by a unanimous vote of his peers after sharing the honor in 2013-14, has led the Vermont Catamounts to a 22-10-3 overall record, the most wins in program history, and a 18-7-2 mark in Hockey East regular season play. The mark was good for a second-place finish in the Army ROTC Hockey East Standings which was the best-ever finish for Vermont in Hockey East play, and doubled the most-ever league wins for the Catamounts (2016-17). Under Plumer, the Catamounts allowed just 693 shots against at even strength, second-fewest of any team in Hockey East. His team's 18.5% power-play conversion rate was also second in the league, while Vermont claimed the best penalty kill in the conference at 91.8%, good for third nationally, and the most shorthanded goals with four.

Hockey East Names Women's Pro Ambitions All-Rookie Team *Five Other Award Winners Announced for 2021-22 Season*

AMESBURY, Mass. - The Hockey East Association today announced the 2021-22 Pro Ambitions All-Rookie Team and five other season-long awards as voted by the women's league's 10 head coaches as part of the celebration of the 20th annual Hockey East Tournament.

The 2021-22 Pro Ambitions All-Rookie Team consists of seven players and includes goaltenders **Callie Shanahan** (Commerce, Mich./Boston University) and **Megan Warrenner** (Stoney Creek, Ont./UConn), a single defenseman in **Courtney Colarulla** (Ayer, Mass./Maine) and forwards **Skylar Irving** (Kingston, Mass./Northeastern), **Kira Juodikis** (Lasalle, Ont./New Hampshire), **Reagan Miller** (Cary, N.C./Vermont), and **Abby Newhook** (St. John's, N.L./Boston College).

Also recognized for their efforts in the 2021-22 campaign are a pair of senior defenders named Co-Best Defenseemen in Northeastern senior **Skylar Fontaine** (East Greenwich, R.I.) and Vermont senior **Maude Poulin-Labelle** (Sherbrooke, Que.). Poulin-Labelle is the first Vermont player to be so honored while Fontaine was the first Husky to win the award since its inception in 2009-10 and is now the first player to win it three times in a row.

Vermont graduate forward **Alyssa Holmes** (Burlington, Ont.) has been honored as the best defensive forward during the regular season, the first Catamount to win the award since **Erin Wente** in 2012-13.

Maine graduate forward **Taylor Leech** (Bowdoinham, Maine) was awarded the conference's sportsmanship award. Leech has played 128 games in a Black Bears sweater and amassed just 32 penalty minutes in conference play.

Two statistical awards were also formally announced, as **Theresa Schafzahl** (Weiz, Austria) was the league's top scorer (21g, 18a, 39p), the first Catamount to lead the league in scoring, while Schafzahl also earned the title of PNC Bank Three Stars Award winner. The senior forward accumulated the highest total of points from first, second, and third star accolades during Hockey East league games over the course of the regular season.

Women's Semifinals Set for Wednesday

Northeastern, Vermont To Host Maine and UConn In Final Week of League Tournament

HOCKEY EAST HEADLINES

Northeastern took its first step toward an unprecedented fifth-straight Bertagna Trophy, taking an 8-0 win over Merrimack in the Hockey East Quarterfinal on Saturday. The Huskies were paced by **Maureen Murphy**, who tallied her fourth hat trick of the season and ninth-ever in a Hockey East playoff game. **Skylar Fontaine** had two assists and now sits just three points away from setting the career mark for points in the Hockey East Women's Tournament.

Vermont earned a 4-1 win to move into the semifinals for the third time in program history. Led by Hockey East scoring champion **Theresa Schafzahl** started the Catamounts postseason run with a goal just 1:58 into the contest and closed out the win with an empty-netter for her 25th goal of the year, extending her own UVM single-season record.

Maine advanced to the third straight semifinal appearance with a 2-1 win at Boston College, backboned by back-up goaltender **Jorden Mattison**, who was nearly perfect, stopping 27 of 28 shots she faced. The Black Bears have been in the semifinals in four of the last five years but not yet appeared in a title game.

UConn earned its third consecutive berth in the semifinals with a 3-1 victory over Boston University. The Huskies got goals from three separate players to complete a come-from-behind win after BU's **Courtney Correa** scored just 43 seconds into the first period.

Merrimack won its first Hockey East Tournament game in program history on Wednesday, earning a 4-1 win on the road at New Hampshire. **Teghan Inglis** scored her fourth point in three games, scoring a shorthanded goal, while **Emma Gorski** stopped 30 shots.

Providence advanced to the quarterfinals with a 3-1 opening round win over Holy Cross. **Hunter Barnett** dished out an assist on each of the three tallies for the Friars.

Aerin Frankel (Gr., G; Briarcliff Manor, N.Y.) posted an 18-save shutout in the 8-0 quarterfinal win over Merrimack. Frankel's shutout was her 11th of the season, a mark that leads the nation and counted as her 100th career victory. Frankel became just the sixth woman in NCAA Division I history with 100 career wins.

Morgan Wabick, UConn (Gr., F; Winnipeg, Man.) Scored a goal and added an assist to lift UConn to a 3-1 victory over Boston University and into the Hockey East Semifinals.

Alyssa Wruble, ME (Fr., F; Bethlehem, Pa.) Scored an unassisted goal in the 2-1 victory over Boston College. Her score came with just 2.1 seconds left in the first period to knot the game at 1-1.

Jorden Mattison, ME (So., G; Fenwick, Ont.) Stopped 27 of 28 shots she faced in the playoff victory over Boston College, 2-1. She made a key save in the final minute of the game in a six-on-five opportunity for the Eagles.

Skylar Fontaine, NU (Gr., D; East Greenwich, R.I.) Posted two assists and one block while leading the Husky defense to its NCAA-best 14th shutout of the season in the 8-0 quarterfinal victory over Merrimack. Fontaine's 38 assists lead the country and she is currently riding an eight-game point streak (3g, 14).

Jessie McPherson, UVM (So., G; Chatham, Ont.) Made 31 saves Saturday in Vermont's 4-1 Quarterfinals win over Providence. With the win she became the third goalie in UVM playoff history with a tournament win.
