### HOCKEY EAST HEADLINES

No. 14 UConn and No. 11 Boston College split a weekend series in league play with the home team taking victory in each contest. On Friday, two goals from rookie **Lauren Glaser** and a shorthanded strike from **Julia Pellerin** lifted the Eagles. The next day in Storrs, **Kyla Josifovic** had the primary helper on both UConn goals in a 2-1 win while **Tia Chan** stopped 19 of 21 shots.

Providence skated to a 1-0-1 weekend against Harvard, with heroics coming from **Reichen Kirchmair**, who scored two goals, including the overtime winner, in a 3-2 win on Saturday after she netted the shootout winner in a 2-2 draw with the Crimson on Friday.

New Hampshire skated to a 1-0 win over Vermont on Friday with rookie defender **Callista Printz** scoring her first career goal, proving to be the decisive tally. **Sedona Blair** extended her shutout streak to 120:21 with a 21-save outing.

Merrimack's **Abby Poitras** netted her first two career goals in a 3-2 setback at RPI on Friday.

Vermont has allowed just nine goals in their last seven games and three goals in their last four but have gone 1-4-2 in that stretch. Goaltender **Jane Gervais** has stopped 117 of 123 shots in her last five starts.
